## *Custom-built pit is CHDI grand prize*

Community Health Development Inc. (CHDI) has received a donation in memory of Tex Elliott from Jan Elliott in support of the Center for Community Wellness at 908 S. Evans St. in Uvalde. The Center for Community Wellness includes CHDI's oral health department, a fitness/exercise center and the teaching kitchen.

Elliot is donating a \$4,300 custom-built barbecue pit and trailer from Texas Best Pits as the grand prize in a drawing to be held at 6 p.m. on March 24. The drawing will take place at Our Health/Nuestro Centro de Salud, 200 S. Evans.
